Media Types

CBRN-Analysis can use 2 types of media to exchange information:

LAN communication

E-mail communication

The media is not part of CBRN-Analysis but must be installed (available) on the computer e.g.

LAN requires LAN connection to other computers

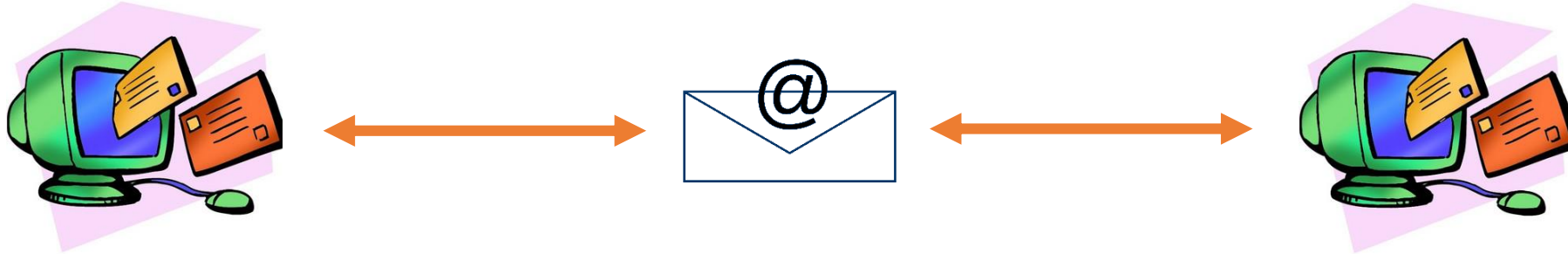
E-mail requires an e-mail account on the computer

The e-mail must be e.g. Outlook or an Exchange server - a mail account in the cloud e.g. Hotmail or Gmail cannot be used

Exchange using E-mail Media

Information exchange between computers requires that the computers have the same type of media available

Computers with e-mail only can only communicate with other computers with e-mail

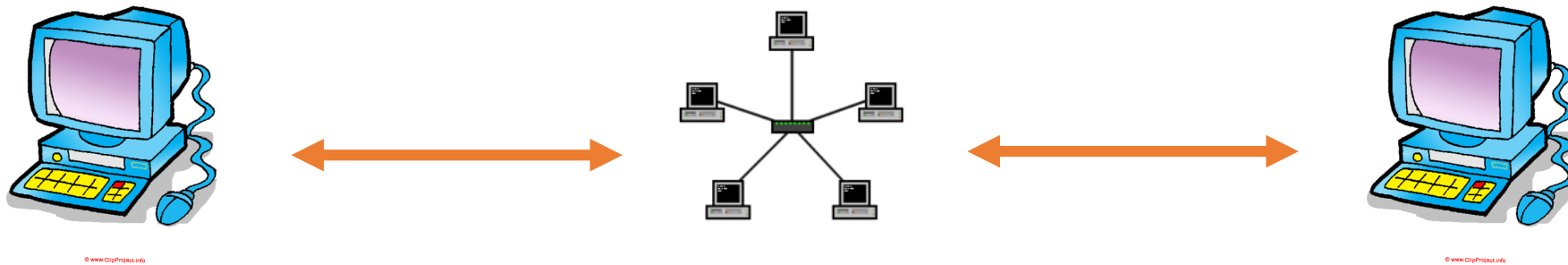


Note: Computers with e-mail and WiFi are able to communicate via Mobile Hot Spots

Exchange using LAN Media

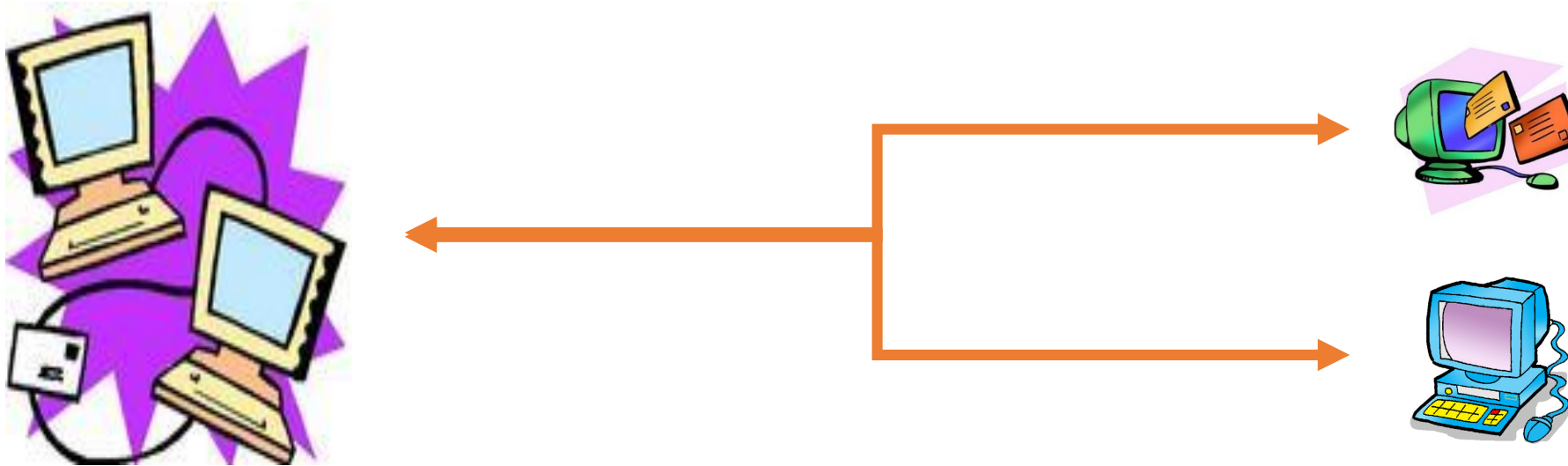
Information exchange between computers requires that the computers have the same type of media available

Computers with LAN only can only communicate with other computers connected to the same LAN



Exchange using LAN and E-mail Media

Computers with LAN and E-mail can communicate with other computers having either LAN or e-mail



Note: Computers with e-mail can transmit CBRN reports to other units without CBRN-Analysis if they just have e-mail

Mailboxes

“Mailboxes” must be established for the available media

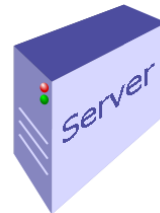

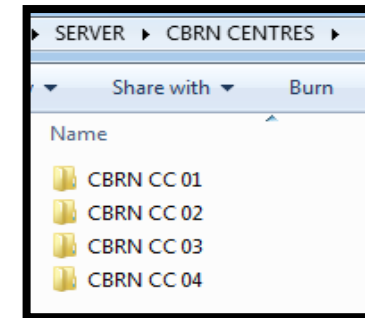

But it can have two mailboxes - dependent on the available media type
