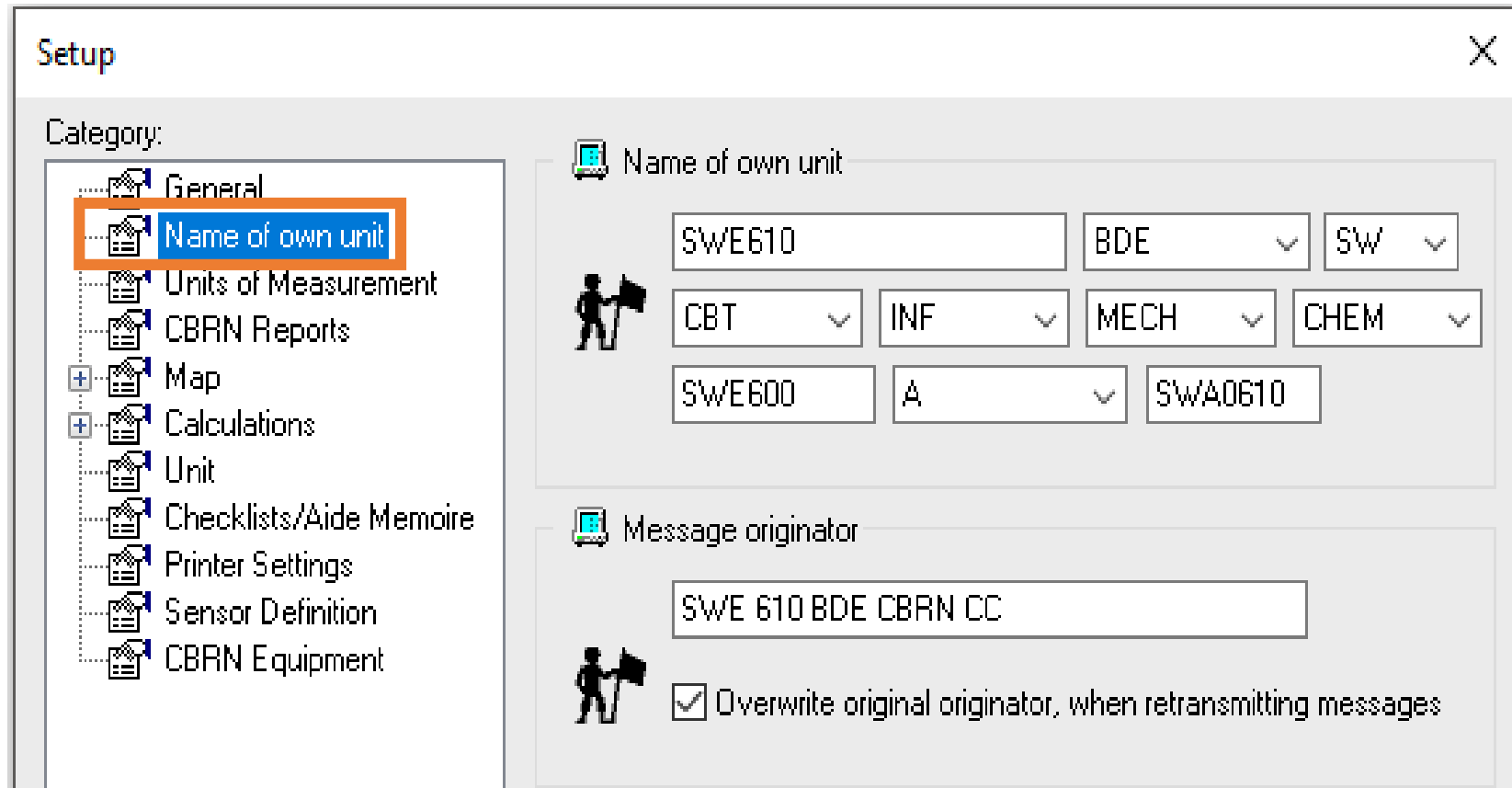

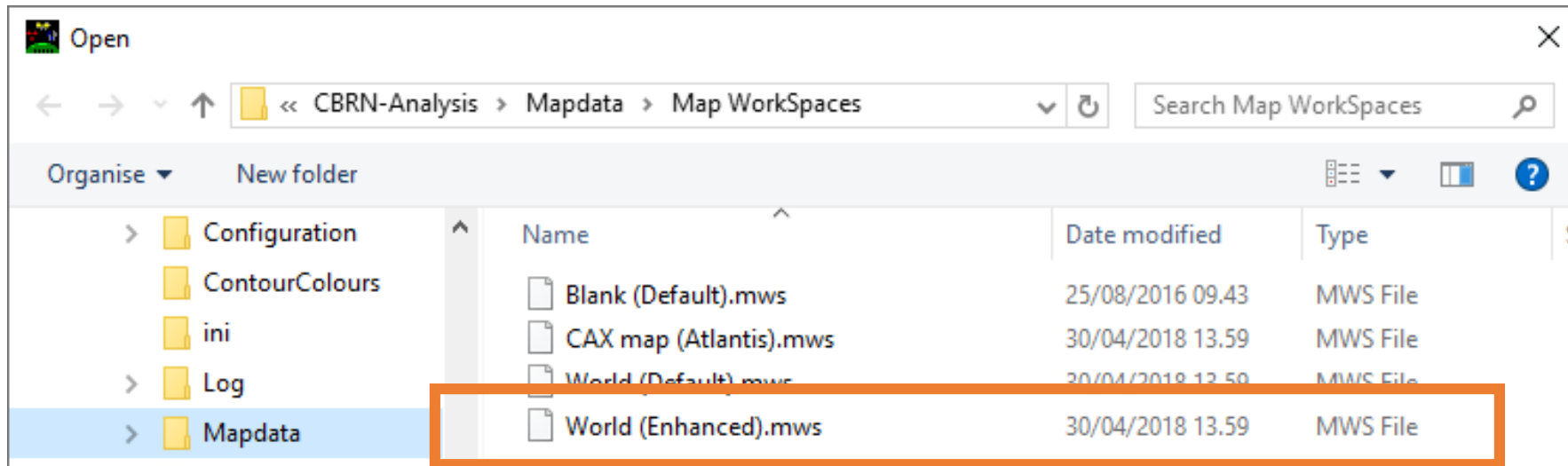

Start with filling in “Name of own Unit” as the example from the Getting Started Guide



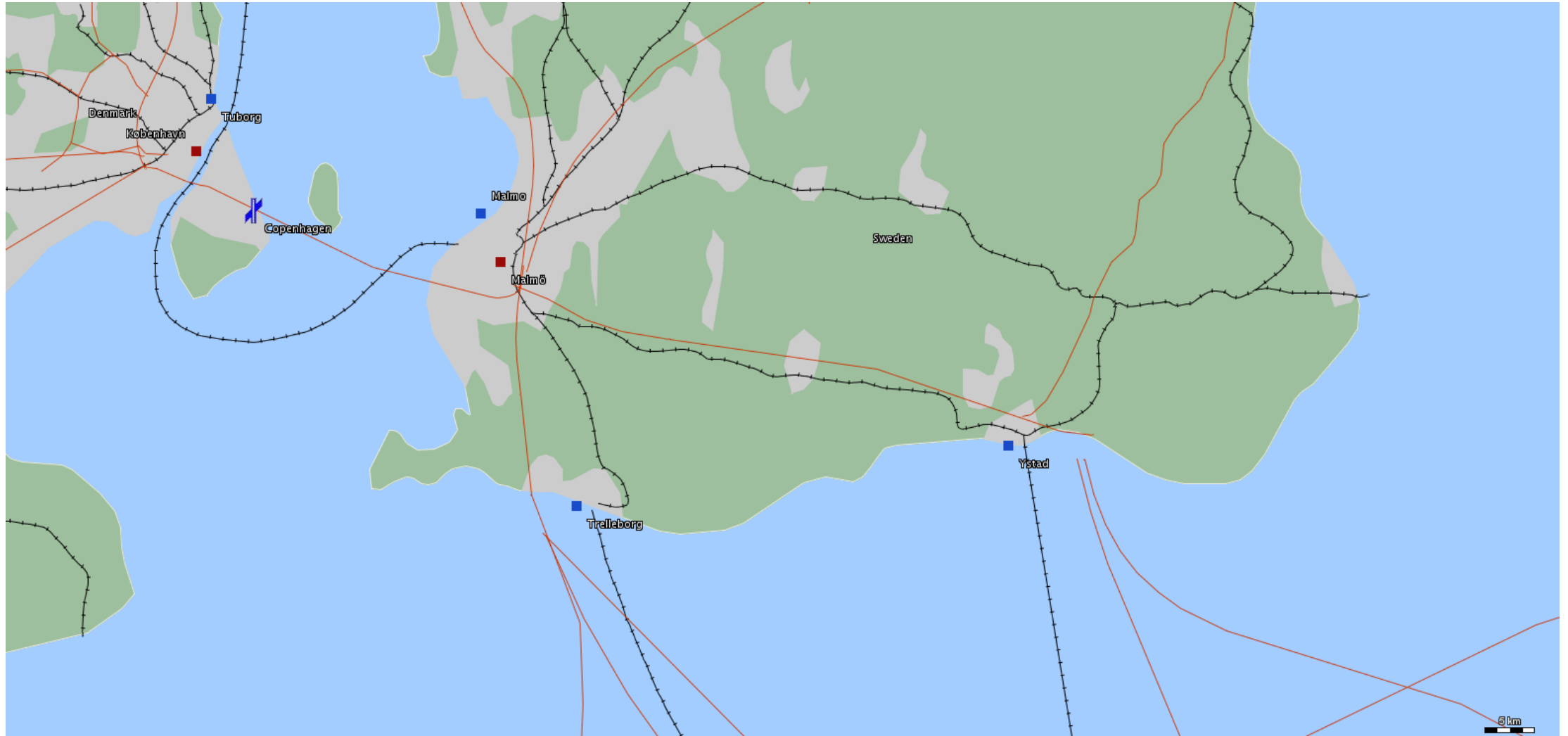
Open Map



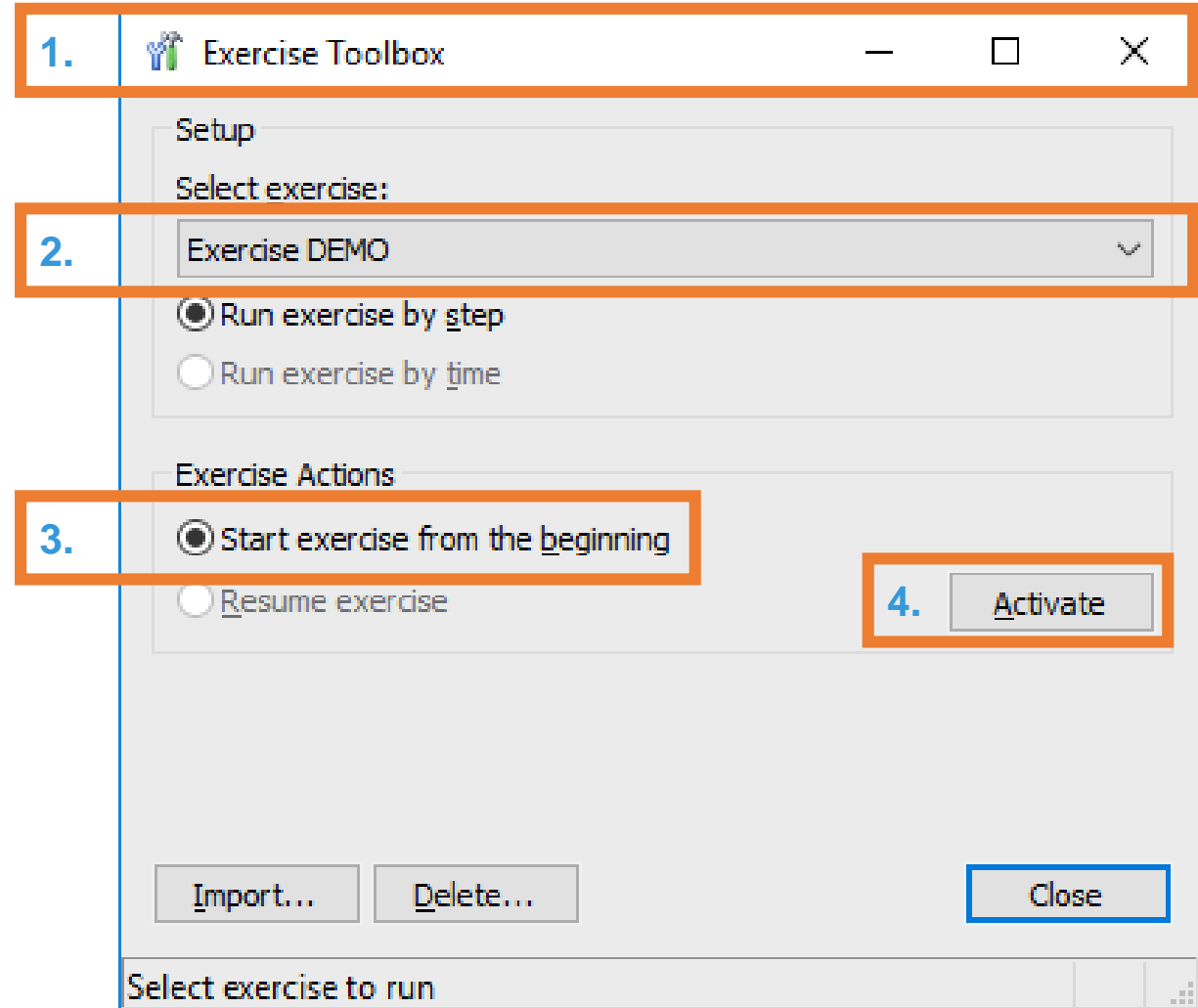
Open Map: World (Enhanced).mws

Note: After the installation you only have the four standard maps in this selection dialogue

Select (zoom to) the exercise area

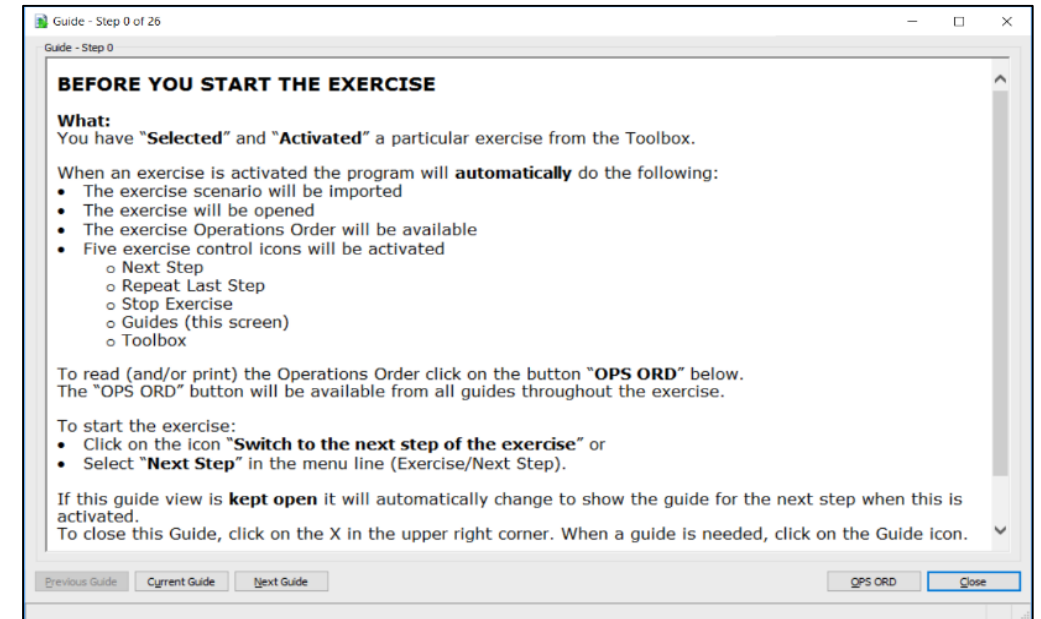


1. Select Exercise Toolbox
2. Select the Exercise (DEMO)
3. Run by step
4. Start from begin...
5. Activate

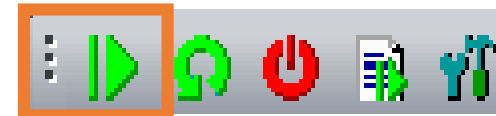


Receive and act on Messages

When the exercise is activated, the scenario is automatically created and existing databases are overwritten – the first guide is shown with start info



Exercise menu icons become available

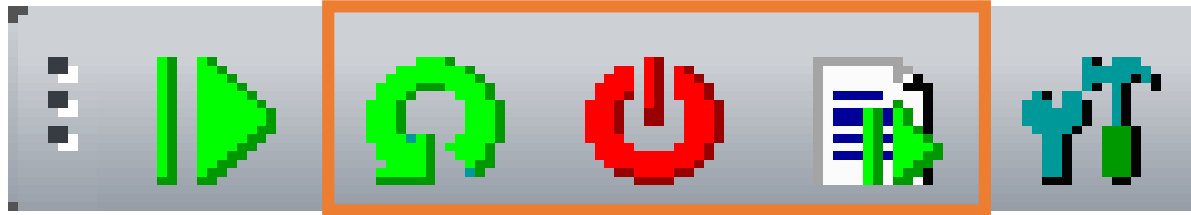


Click on “Next Step” to receive Orders, Units, CBRN reports etc. via the mail box.

Respond to injects as you would do in a CBRN Centre

(in this case the SWE610 Brigade) and carry on until the last inject

Run and Stop the Exercise



- Click on repeat to get the latest inject one more time
- Click on Guide to look at the guides for the current step
- Click on “Stop Exercise” to stop the exercise temporary or to terminate the exercise module after the last step



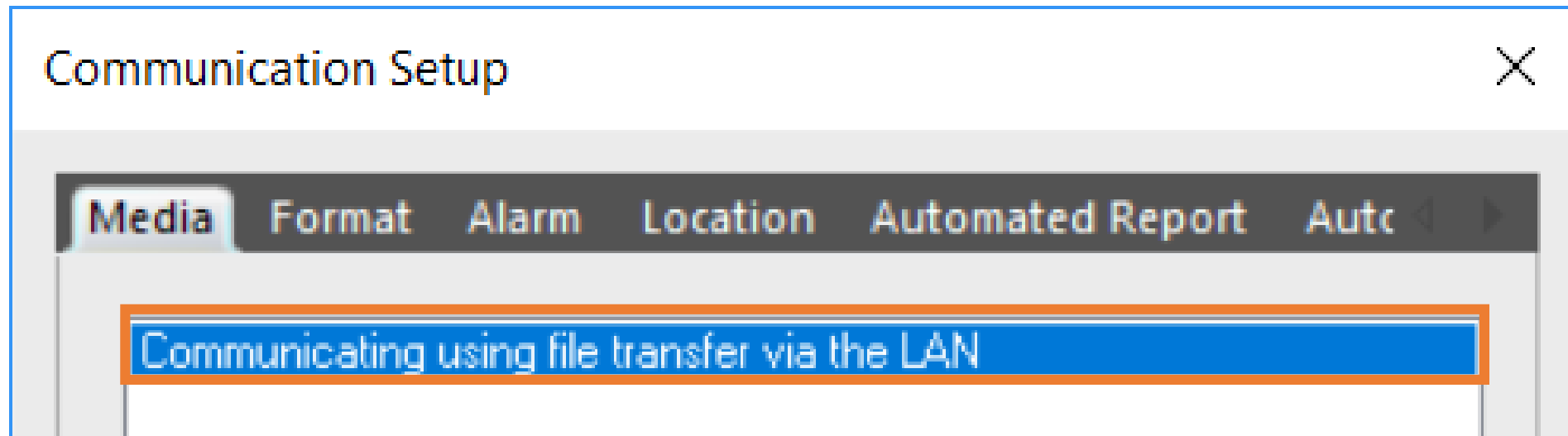
The following slides repeat and expand the settings and procedures (if needed)



Communication

CAX Exercise module uses the LAN communication media, i.e.

- LAN Media must be set up before use
- Any mailbox (lan path) may be selected as only the media is used, not the mailbox path



Procedure

The following settings should be made:

- Name of own Unit (SWE610 from the Getting Started Guide)
- Make sure that LAN communication is selected as media
- Open the map World (Enhanced).mws

- Click on Next will send a message to your mail inbox
- Open the mail and retrieve the message
- Respond to the mail e.g. if it is a CBRN 1 report
 - Retrieve it from the mailbox
 - Calculate to get a CBRN 2 report
 - Give the CBRN 2 report an incident number (ALFA field)
 - Approve the CBRN 2 report and transmit it to e.g. the HQ
 - Use normal CBRN Centre tasks e.g. look at units at risk etc.
 - Continue with the next mail until the last step

Incidents and Resume

The DEMO exercise WARM-UP follows the incidents from the Getting Started Guide exercise Warm-Up, but continues with a few more incidents to extend the program practice

The exercise module remembers the step where you stopped the exercise.

To resume the exercise:

- Open the toolbox
- Select the exercise you stopped
- Click on Resume Exercise
- The exercise will repeat your last input (mail)
